We can't think of a better way to move through this year than with the Bible at the forefront of every day, decision, and moment. We will Seek First.




IT'S NOT ABOUT US.

• That our senior adults will see this season of their lives as their greatest opportunity to pour into others.

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




LEVITICUS 26:12

WE ARE UNAFRAID TO DO THINGS THAT NO ONE IS DOING TO REACH PEOPLE NO ONE ELSE IS REACHING.

We are familiar with the story of David and Goliath. The shepherd boy took down the giant with a slingshot and a stone. Do you remember when young David stepped up to fight Goliath? King Saul offered David his battle amor (1 Samuel 17:38-40). The armor had always worked for King Saul, but on David it was it was bulky and awkward and inhibited his ability to leverage his skills to fight the giant. In the same way, we recognize there are typical, logical ways of doing things, things that have even worked in the past, but they might inhibit our efforts to reach or relate to certain people.

Conventional wisdom, tradition, and even comfort can keep us from reaching those outside our walls. The Gospel and the unwavering truth of God's Word remain the cornerstone of our message, but sometimes our methods may need to adjust. What works today might not work tomorrow. What works tomorrow might not work forever. Because God's ways are not ours, we will have the courage to innovate and the wisdom to adapt. We will make changes and step out of our comfort zone to cross divides so that everyone can experience the freedom of the Gospel and live united in Christ.




• For every UC Kid to become more aware of and excited about God's love and purpose for them, both now and in the future.


• For our college-age students and young adults to rise up, lead, and lean into God's direction and will.


JOHN 1:1-2

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




