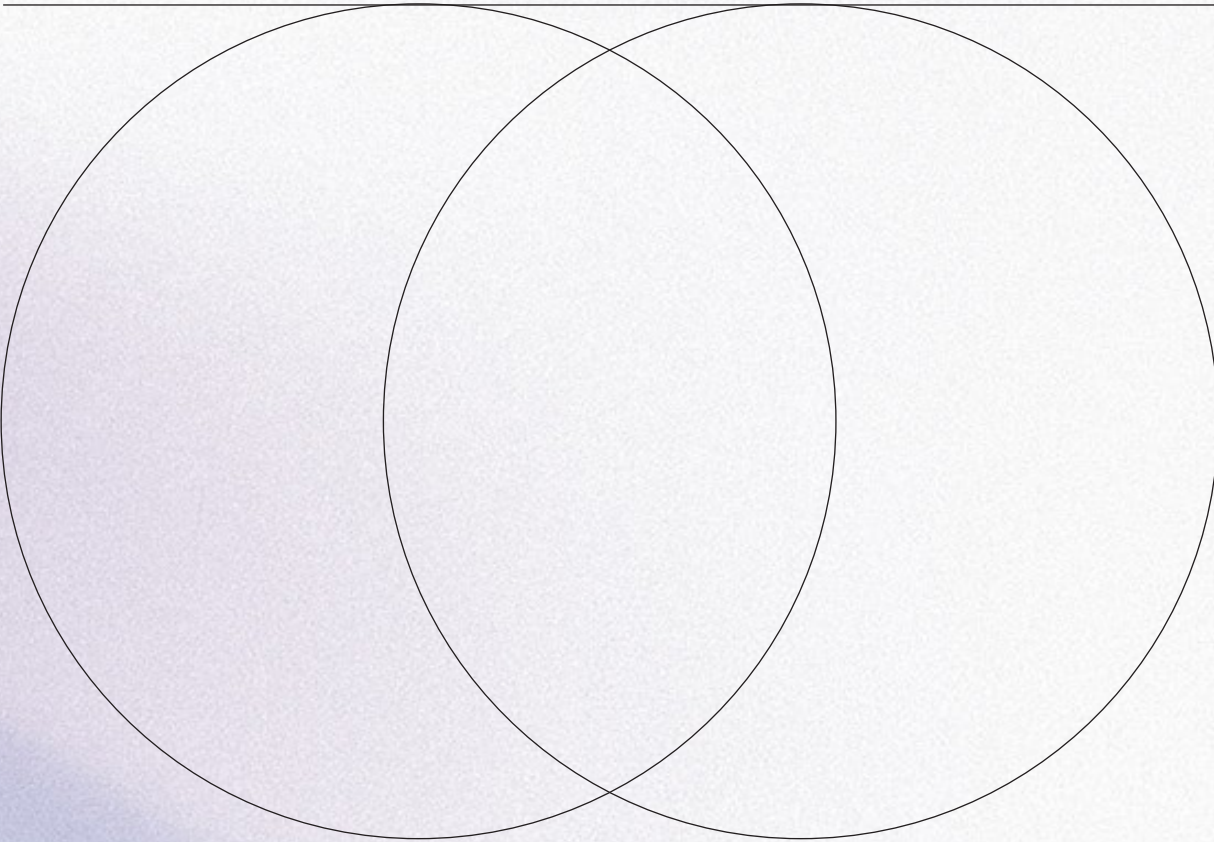

EVERYONE HAS A NEXT STEP.

GOD CAN DO MORE THAN WE CAN DO... BUT WE CAN DO SOMETHING.

Joshua 10:6-15 tells the story of how the Israelite army miraculously defeated the Amorites. The Lord told them ahead of time that they would be victorious, but the Israelites still marched through the night and fought a difficult battle. Then Joshua prayed, not that they would be relieved from their battle, but that the sun would stand still so they could keep fighting...and God did it!

We need to be prepared to use the gifts, talents, abilities, and resources God has given us—whether in the marketplace or church— to do what He has called us to do. That means we don't simply sit back and ask God to work on our behalf, we faithfully do what we can do; we fight, we pursue, we obey, we discipline ourselves, we make ourselves uncomfortable, we strive knowing that in all things we depend on the God that created the universe and can make the sun stand still. We know that when we are obedient, He will step in and do what we cannot.

PRAYER PROMPTS

- For a desperate hunger and thirst for Jesus, His Word, and a renewed perspective of His kingdom.
- That UC Kids would experience more lives changed and more baptisms than we have seen before, and families would be transformed as a result.
- For depth and discipleship within our existing Life Groups, and for awareness to see the opportunities around us to cross divides and invite others in.

We are familiar with the story of David and Goliath. The shepherd boy took down the giant with a slingshot and a stone. Do you remember when young David stepped up to fight Goliath? King Saul offered David his battle armor (1 Samuel 17:38-40). The armor had always worked for King Saul, but on David it was bulky and awkward and inhibited his ability to leverage his skills to fight the giant. In the same way, we recognize there are typical, logical ways of doing things, things that have even worked in the past, but they might inhibit our efforts to reach or relate to certain people.

Conventional wisdom, tradition, and even comfort can keep us from reaching those outside our walls. The Gospel and the unwavering truth of God's Word remain the cornerstone of our message, but sometimes our methods may need to adjust. What works today might not work tomorrow. What works tomorrow might not work forever. Because God's ways are not ours, we will have the courage to innovate and the wisdom to adapt. We will make changes and step out of our comfort zone to cross divides so that everyone can experience the freedom of the Gospel and live united in Christ.

PRAYER PROMPTS

- For every UC Kid to become more aware of and excited about God's love and purpose for them, both now and in the future.
- For strong and passionate leaders to rise up in our Español ministry; that we would have more Español SERVE Team in all areas of ministry at UC (Kids, UCY, Adults, Worship/Media) so we are able to reach more and more Spanish speakers in our community.
- That our hearts would be for the lost and that we would recognize every opportunity we have to share the love of Jesus with those around us.
